TOURNAMENT RULES ARE ON THE BACK OF THIS FLYER

“Tight Lines And Good Fishing”

Rules Are As Follows:

- **\$25.00 Entry Fee Per Boat, \$5.00 Optional Big Bass**
- Cash Only, No Pre-paying
- Maximum Of Two Anglers Per Boat
- No Membership Dues
- 10% Of The Total Entry Fees Will Go In The Classis Fund
- 100% Of The Remaining Proceeds Will Be Paid Back At The Tournament
- 12 Boats Or More And Two Big Fish Places Will Be Paid 60% To 1st Big Fish And 40% To 2nd Big Fish
- Classic Will Be Drawn From The Bodies Of Water Fished*
- Each Angler Must Fish At Least 6 Of The 10 Tournaments To Qualify For The Classic
- Records Will Be Kept And The 8 Anglers That Finish With The Highest Points Out Of Their Top 6 Tournaments Fished Will Represent Our Club In The Annual Tournament Of Champions
- 3 Places Will Be Paid Regardless Of Number Of Boats, If 20 To 25 Boats 4 Places Will Be Paid, If 26 To 30 Boats 5 Places Will Be Paid And So On.
- 5 Fish Limit Per Boat (Largemouth & Smallmouth Bass Only)
- 12 Inch Size Limit (Waivers Will Be Provided For Talquin)
- Only Artificial Lures May Be Used (No Trolling)
- You Must Launch Your Boat At The Specified Tournament Launch Site To Be Eligible To Fish The Tournament Unless You Have Contacted The Tournament Director Mitch Lawhon Prior To The Tournament & Gotten Approval To Launch At A Different Ramp.
- You Will Be Required To Register At The Tournament Location Prior To Blast-Off To Be Eligible To Fish Unless You Have Contacted The Tournament Director Prior to Blast-Off And Worked Out Your Situation.
- Tournaments Will Begin At Daylight And End At 3:00pm EST except for the tournament on 06/01/2013 at Lake Talquin which will start at 10:00am and end at 6:30pm
- 1 Pound Will Be Deducted Per Minute Late To Weigh-In
- ¼ Pound Will Be Deducted Per Dead Fish
- If An Illegal Fish Is Brought To The Scales You Will Lose The Fish Plus 1 Pound From Your Total Weight
- Must Be At Least 18 Years Old Or Accompanied By An Adult To Fish
